The event will be in person (subject to Covid restrictions, and bound by Covid rules), and available to watch online, but will not be recorded. Racism is an issue for everyone involved with the club, so everyone is invited. However, we want an open discussion, so it is parental discretion if they are happy for their children to take part. Note it is the intention to run a similar session for the junior section later in 2022, suitably planned and framed.
